The Enrichment program is offered each Wednesday afternoon (early dismissal day) at Audubon Elementary School. Each class meeting is one hour in length and serves children 1-5th grades. Instructors come from many different backgrounds and are often members of the community, parents, graduate students, and retirees dedicated to sharing their crafts, life experiences, and hobbies to children in the community. Participation in after school enrichment programs have a proven benefit for your children, your family and the

community you live in.

The goals of the program include:

- To help the student have fun and feel good about themselves as they expand their horizons.
- Create a better community by facilitating the development of well-rounded children.

## Registration Policies and Procedures

- Only students enrolled in 1-5th grades at Audubon Elementary School are eligible for the Wednesday Enrichment program.
- Spaces are filled by a first come, first served basis.
- Internet registration will be open 24 hrs a day seven (7) days a week. Families without internet access may submit registration through the walk in system.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for printing out a copy of their internet receipt. Additional confirmations will not be issued by the Department.
- Walk in registration will receive a hard-copy via USPS.

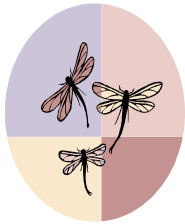
