Glow Ball Golf Tournament

This rulebook is designed to acquaint golf managers, players and sponsors with specific tournament rules and conditions of play set forth by the Foster City Parks and Recreation Department for the Adult Glow Ball Golf Tournament.

It is important for all participants to become familiar with the information contained in the following pages.

It is the intent of the Foster City Parks and Recreation Department to provide an opportunity for adults to take part in an organized and structured athletic program which will enable its participants to achieve a sense of personal enjoyment and physical development.

Please keep in mind the value of sportsmanship when playing in recreational sports.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The 2011 Fall Glow Ball Golf Tournament is scheduled for Saturday, September 24th at Mariners Point Golf Course (2401 E, 3rd Avenue, Foster City).
- Tournament Website: www.fostercity.org/sports
- Registration Information: Each team must complete the 2011 Fall Glow Ball Golf Tournament registration form and submit the registration fee.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

- Foster City offers two tournaments per year, a spring tournament in March, and a fall tournament in September.

TEAM ROSTERS:

- A completed roster is due at registration. All teams must have 5 players*. Please print all names legibly on the registration form.

** Teams with less players may participate with permission from Recreation Staff.*

PRE-GAME AND GROUND RULES:

1. All teams must arrive at the golf course at 6:30pm and check in with Tournament Staff to see where your team will be teeing off from.
2. First round will begin at 7pm, the second will begin at 9pm. Both will begin with a shotgun start. *Shotgun start- teams tee off simultaneously from different holes*
3. 9 holes of regular play will be played at 7pm, followed by 9 holes of “Lights Out Glow Ball” play at 9pm.
4. This is a “Scramble” tournament- all players will hit once, and play from the best ball.
5. Flashlights are permitted but are not to be used to read the greens.

PLAYOFF RULES:

- In the event of a tie, teams will replay Hole #1 to determine the winner.

AWARDS:

- First Place Team wins individual trophies.

MISC INFORMATION:

- In the event of rain on the day of the tournament, the tournament will be rescheduled for a later date. A representative from the Foster City Parks and Recreation Department will notify teams by 3pm on September 24th if the event is cancelled.
- If tournament is interrupted by unforeseen circumstances (i.e. unexpected bad weather), teams will cease play and the win-loss record will be computed on the games actually played/completed.
