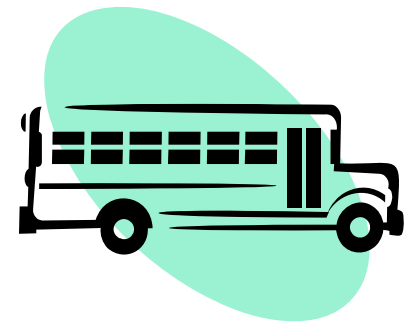

Services Provided

The Senior Express Bus Program has three transportation components which include:

- Door-to-door Service
- Local Trips
- Charter Service

Territory Covered

The Senior Express operates within the following boundaries:

N—Burlingame (Trousdale Ave.-Mills Hospital), & Millbrae BART

S—Redwood City Kaiser (exceptions to Stanford Hospital)

E—San Mateo Bridge

W—Up to 280

Bus Fees

Daily Rides:

The payment method for the Senior Express is a punch card. Punch cards can be purchased at the Senior Wing front desk or can be mailed to your home, **after** a check has been received by the Senior Wing front desk staff. ***No payment will be accepted on the bus.***

In Town Bus Pass

6-pack Punch Card:
\$12 (\$2/ride)

10-pack Punch Card:
\$18 (1 free)

20-pack Punch Card:
\$30 (5 free)

Out of Town Bus Pass

6-pack Punch Card:
\$30 (\$5/ride)

10-pack Punch Card:
\$45 (1 free)

20-pack Punch Card:
\$75 (5 free)

Local Trips:

Prices for local trips will be determined by the Senior Programs Coordinator and will be advertised accordingly.

Charter Service:

The Senior Express is available for rent at a price that is less than the typical market price for a shuttle bus. Currently, the Senior Express rental rates are as follows:

\$60/hr for the first 8 hours; \$75/hr for more than 8 hours. For further information, please call 286.3378.

Policy Guidelines

Daily Rides:

- Users must be Foster City residents age 55 or older, exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis
- Reservations must be made by 1pm the day before reservation requested pick up time
- Reservations can be made up to 2 weeks in advance
- Senior Express bus driver has the discretion of calling riders upon departure to inform rider that he will be arriving within the next few minutes for pick up
- The Senior Express bus driver will not wait more than 5 minutes for a rider to come out of their house (riders must be ready)
- Payment/punch card is to be presented (to the driver) at the beginning of each ride, before taking a seat on the bus

- If payment is not received (withheld) a total of 3 times, rider privileges may be suspended for a one month period

- Rides must be cancelled one hour before the reservation or the rider will be charged a one-way fare

Local Trips:

- RSVP *with* payment is required
- No refunds will be given one week prior to trip
- Reminder phone calls to trip participants are not guaranteed
- Participants must arrive at least 5 minutes prior to scheduled departure
- Participants must complete a new medical waiver on a bi-annual basis

Rentals:

- Application, deposit, and waiver are required, deposit may be waived on a case-by-case basis
- Deposit checks are held until the rental is complete; exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis
- Cancellations:
 - One-time rentals: Renter must cancel at least two business days in advance or will be charged 25% of the agreed rental.
 - Ongoing rentals: Renter must cancel before the third rental to avoid a cancellation fee. If renter cancels after the third rental, renter will be charged 25% of the remaining rental agreement.
