

# Friendly Streets, Foster City



Due to the increase in recreational activity along the Levee Pedway, the goal of *Friendly Streets, Foster City* is to make our streets friendlier and safer, as well as to sufficiently provide physical space for pedestrians, runners, and bicyclists.

- Approximately a 1.75 mile stretch of road on northbound Beach Park Blvd (from Foster City Blvd to Teal Street) will be designated for safe use by bicyclists and runners by barricading off the right lane from cars.
- Bicyclists and runners will detour through Bridgeview Park to get back to the pedway.
- No turn movements will be affected.
- The City requests bicyclists and runners to courteously use the detour and reserve the pedway for walking.
