What Age Qualifies for Senior Housing

Generally, all occupants of the household need to be age 62 or older to qualify for senior housing. However, some properties permit additional younger household members as long as they are 55 or older.

How Many Affordable Senior Properties are in Foster City?

There are two affordable senior properties in the City of Foster City: Metro Center Senior Apartments, owned by BRIDGE Housing, and Alma Point at Foster Square, with 65 one-bedroom apartments.
