

Program Description



How it Works

HIP Housing's Home Sharing Program is a living arrangement in which two or more unrelated people share a home or apartment. Each has his/her private room and shares the common areas.

Home sharing reduces costs, promotes independence, provides companionship and increases security for both home provider and seeker.

Home Sharing services include:

- Personal housing consultants
- Service exchange arrangements
- Facilitation of Living Together Agreement
- Home sharing match follow up
- Linkage to alternate community services
- Home visits to home bound and disabled seniors

HIP Housing can facilitate two types of home sharing arrangements:

Rent Exchange

A home provider is matched with a home seeker who pays rent, in order to reduce housing and utility costs for both parties. The majority of matches faciliatated by HIP Housing involve exchange of rent.

Service Exchange

Typically involving seniors and entails a home seeker who agrees to provide services in lieu of rent or for reduced rent. Service exchanges do not involve medical, hands-on care, but rather an exchange of light cooking, cleaning and chores.

To arrange for an interview at one of HIP Housing's four offices, call our main office in San Mateo at 650.348.6660. You will be given an appointment with one of our Housing Consultants to complete an application. HIP Housing has field offices in Daly City, Redwood City and South San Francisco. Home visits are available to home bound clients when needed.

At your appointment you must have:

- Names and phone numbers of three references
- Written verification of your income
- Photo I.D.
