Dear Ms. Chen:

Thank you for submitting your architectural application to the homeowners association for review. The Board of Directors has reviewed and approved your request to replace your furnace contingent the two PVC pipes (as per the attached drawing #8215) must not stick out more than the existing vent; it must fit within the housing that will eventually be placed over those vents. You must make sure to look at how much room you have for the venting. In addition, the condensation line, near the bottom of the wall, must have some kind of way of collecting the water, so that the condensation water isn't continuously dripping on the deck. You can stick a plant under it, but something must collect the water. During the icy months that water becomes trail of ice on the decks, creating a slip hazard.

This approval is also subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All work must be completed according to the plans submitted.
- 2. Any additional improvements omitted from the approved plan cannot be completed without resubmitting the plan and receiving written approval from the Committee.
- 3. During the improvements, all areas around the lot must be kept neat and clean.
- 4. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that any and all city or county requirements, such as, but not limited to, permits and inspections are satisfied.
- 5. No contractor signage is to be posted before, during or after any project is completed.
