PROGRAM INFO

- A child may only be registered for a class at the school they attend.
- Registration closes on a specific date to allow staff to finalize rosters with the instructors and the schools.
- If a class does not meet its minimum enrollment, it will be cancelled.
 - Your child will be transferred into their second-choice option that you indicated during the registration process. If that class is unavailable, you will be provided with a full refund.
- Transfers/refunds must be requested before the start of the second class and will be prorated based on the number of classes held, not attended. All refunds incur a \$10 administrative fee. For rained out classes, refunds will be processed at the end of the session.
- If there is any rain forecast after 12pm, all outdoor classes will be cancelled and refunds will be provided after the session.
- Behavior policy: all participants are expected to treat staff, instructors, and other students with courtesy and respect; no aggressive language and/or behaviors will be tolerated. The full behavior policy will be sent with the parent welcome letter.
