### **Program Description**

All volunteer hours will count towards community service!

The Parks & Recreation Department offers a creative and fun Counselor in Training (C.I.T) program designed to develop young teens into leaders. Foster City Summer Camp staff are looking for teens to volunteer for our 2018 Summer Camp Programs (Kamp Koala, Camp Outback, & Camp Wayoutback). The C.I.T program gives teens the opportunity to prepare for future employment through an interview process to strengthen their skills, experience working with youth, training opportunities, and a chance to serve in leading roles throughout the day in camp.

#### C.I.T. Application/Selection Process

- 1. Applications are located at the Recreation Center (650 Shell Blvd.), Teen Center (670 Shell Blvd.) or online (<a href="www.fostercity.org/parksandrecreation/CIT">www.fostercity.org/parksandrecreation/CIT</a>). Spaces are limited!
- 2. You must fill out an application and submit it to the above places by walk-in or e-mail to <a href="mailto:bdieterle@fostercity.org">bdieterle@fostercity.org</a>.
- 3. Applications are due before April 16, 2018 by 5:00pm. Late applications will not be accepted!
- 4. Applicants will then be scheduled for a <u>mandatory</u> CIT Showcase (please see attached flyer for more information).
- 5. After showcases have been completed, accepted applicants will have to attend a mandatory training on Friday, June 22, 2018. Program fees are due after an applicant has been accepted into the program, and must be paid before June 22 or they will not be able to attend training.

### **C.I.T Positions**

#### CIT 1

Candidates may select to volunteer between <u>4-6 weeks</u>. Candidate may have little or no previous volunteer experience in camps. They will choose either a morning (9:00am-1:00pm) or afternoon (12:00pm-4:00pm) shift (unable to go on field trip days, will be relocated temporarily to another camp for field trip days). CIT 1's are responsible for assisting staff with supervision of campers, providing assistance to staff, learning the daily camp routine, and interacting with campers. CIT 1 candidates must be entering 8th - 12th grade.

#### CIT 2

Candidates may select to work between <u>3-6 weeks</u>. Candidate must have significant volunteer experience in Foster City camps. They will have a shift from 9:00am-4:00pm (including going on field trips). CIT 2's are responsible for assisting staff with implementation of camp activities, assisting with supervision of campers, participating and interacting with campers, and providing ideas for camp activities. CIT 2 candidates must be High School age 9th - 12th grade.
