## CITY OF FOSTER CITY SKATE PARK RULES

- Skate at your own risk. The park is not supervised.
- All skateboarders and in-line skaters must wear a safety helmet, elbow pads, and knee pads at all times. All persons in violation of these rules are subject to citation under city of Foster City Ordinance 10.68.150 and California Health and Safety Code Section 115800B.
- Skateboarding and in-line skating only. Bicycles and BMX's are NOT permitted.
- Please observe Skate Park Hours- 9am-Dusk.
- Youth under 14 years of age must have parental supervision.
- Respect surrounding tennis courts and The Vibe.
- Use appropriate language and respectful behavior when in the facility.
- Animals, alcoholic beverages, tobacco, drugs and drug paraphernalia are NOT permitted on site.
- Keep food and beverages outside of the skate park.
- Additional obstacles (ramps/jumps) may not be used in the skate park.
- Use ramp elements in their intended way and with respect.
- No spectators inside the skate park.
- All participants must skate safely at all times and avoid collisions with other participants. Ramps must be clear of skaters before you proceed.
- Fighting, graffiti, vandalism, or other aggressive or disruptive behavior is not permissible.
- The City of Foster City is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Do not use facility if a hazardous condition exist. Report any damage/hazardous conditions to the City of Foster City Recreation Division at (650) 286-3380.
- All organized events shall have written approval from the Director of Parks and Recreation.

Skateboarding and rollerblading are hazardous recreational activities. Use of this facility may result in death or serious injury. Use at your own risk.
