Mobile Field Force and Force Options Training Outline

Course Objective:

To safely demonstrate knowledge in decision making, officer safety, and making effective decisions under stress.

A. Use of Force Policy (45 Min)

1. Discussion on updates to PC 835 (a) and AB 392.

B. Mobile Field Force (45 Min)

- 1. Discussion on Mobile Field Force/Mutual Aid Responses
- 2. Mobile Field Force Equipment Explain and demonstrate the various uses of each piece of equipment Students will practice donning on their gas masks and helmets
- 3. Mobile Field Force Formations Explain and demonstrate the various formations used at riots

C. Building Searches (20 Min)

- 1. Room search demonstration Explain and demonstrate how to safely search rooms and hallways in groups of 2, 3, and 4 people
- 2. Room search exercise Students will practice the searches with their teams

D. Scenario Training (130 Min)

- 1. Taser or Deady force scenario Students will participate in a scenario which they will have to exercise good judgement in suspect apprehension
- 2. Handcuffing, Taser, and WRAP restraint scenario Students will participate in a scenario which they will have to exercise good judgement in suspect apprehension
- 3. De-escalation scenario Students will participate in a scenario in which they will have to use their verbal skills to resolve a situation
- 4. All force options scenario Students will participate in a scenario which they will have to exercise good judgement in controlling a scene and safely apprehending a suspect

Any student scoring below standard on any exercise, as established by the presenter, will be remediated, and tested until standard is achieved.
