ADDENDUM NO. ONE (1) TO THE PROJECT DOCUMENTS
FOR STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT (2025-2026)

Bid Submittal Due Date: **Wednesday, February 18, 2025 at 2:00pm**

Notice is hereby given that the following revisions, additions, and/or deletions are hereby made a part of, and incorporated into the project documents for Street Rehabilitation Project (2025-2026).

Bidders shall acknowledge the receipt of this Addendum on the Bid Form (00 4113). Failure to do so may render Bidder's Bid non-responsive.

The following changes, additions or deletions shall be made to the following documents as indicated and shall be part thereof as if originally specified and/or shown. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

Construction Services Project Manual:

1. The Bid Form has an error in the description of Item 4A. The description of Item 4A should be **2.5" Grind and 2.5" Asphalt Concrete Overlay**.

REPLACE Document 00 4113 – 3 with the attached and updated Document 00 4113 – 3 with revised description for Item 4A.

2. The required bid document for In- Use Off-Road Diesel-Fueled Fleets Certification is missing. This document must be submitted with the bid.

INSERT the attached Document 00 4548 (In-Use Off-Road Diesel-Fueled Fleets Certification) to be submitted with the bid.

3. Document 00 5200 Section 1.04 has errors in the completion dates. Substantial Completion shall be within 85 calendar days and Final Completion shall be within 90 calendar days.

REPLACE Document 00 5200 Section 1.04 with the following text:

1.04 Completion of Work

- A. Contractor shall achieve Substantial Completion of the entire Work within **85 Calendar Days** from the Commencement Date.
- B. Contractor shall achieve Final Completion of the entire Work within **90 Calendar Days** from the Commencement Date.

4. Document 01 2000 – 2 is updated to reflect expected curb ramp scope.

REPLACE Document 01 2000 Section 1.04 Item A Number 4 with the following text:

4. Curb Ramps (including detectable warning surface). Shall be measured and paid for on a unit price basis per each, which includes, include full compensation for providing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all work including, but not limited to the removal of existing concrete curb ramp/sidewalk, disposal of material, subgrade preparation, aggregate base installation and compaction, proof-rolling, forms, joints, concrete placement, concrete finishing, formwork, reinforcement and dowels, concrete protection and curing, asphalt concrete placement and compaction, up to two (2) foot wide asphalt concrete or concrete conforms with depths matching existing conditions or a minimum of six (6) inches, asphalt concrete behind the back of walk where required per the plans, up to one (1) flag of concrete sidewalk, curb, and gutter on either side of curb as necessary to meet ADA grade compliance, replacement of the concrete swale/apron to the nearest expansion joints for the installation of the curb ramps at the northwest and southwest corners of the intersection of Foster City Blvd and Balclutha Dr, and detectable warning surface shall be considered as included in the contract unit price paid for Curb Ramps and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor. Full compensation of the relocation of any posts, signs, utility boxes and/or any item in conflict with the location of the ramp shall be considered as included in the contract unit price paid and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

5. Document 01 2000 is updated to revise Measurement and Payment for corrected Item 4A.

REPLACE Document 01 2000 Section 1.04 Item B Number 4A with the following text:

4A. 2.5” Grind and 2.5” Asphalt Concrete Overlay. Shall be measured and paid for by the square foot, which includes, but is not limited to furnishing of all labor, material, and services required to properly and safely complete all work related to the “2.5” Grind and 2.5” Asphalt Concrete Overlay” in conformance with Foster City Standard Specifications, Standard Details, as shown on the plans, and as specified in Section 02 2600. This bid item includes the adjustment to final grade of existing utility boxes, valve, vaults, meters, manholes, and monuments located within the asphalt concrete pavement as shown on the plans. Bid item also includes but not limited to any compaction, removal and disposal of striping, backfill, base materials, including aggregate base or permeable material, concrete, reinforcing bars or mesh, forms, expansion joints, scoring and finishing, and miscellaneous materials and labor.

6. Document 02 2600 – 3 has an error in Section 3.02 Pavement Grinding Item C. The minimum overlay is 2.5” inches.

REPLACE Document 02 2600 – 3 Section 3.02 Item C with the following text:

C. For overlay, grind as necessary to allow a minimum overlay of 2.5” inches to new elevations.

7. Document 02 2600 – 4 Section 3.02 Pavement Grinding Item J is updated to revise duration between grind and overlay operations.

REPLACE Document 02 2600 – 4 Section 3.02 Item J with the following text:

J. Ground areas shall be overlaid within 72 hours of grinding.
