(CIP 455-626) SANITARY SEWER LIFT STATION IMPROVEMENTS – PHASE 5**

**CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY NOTICE
(LIFT STATION #21 – KETCH PARK)**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

At the July 17, 2017 District Board meeting, the Estero Municipal Improvement District (EMID) Board of Directors awarded the construction contract for CIP 455-626 to Anderson Pacific Engineering (Contractor). CIP 455-626 is the fifth in a series of projects to rehabilitate existing sanitary sewer lift stations to improve reliability of the wastewater collection system. The project includes rehabilitation of nine lift stations, which includes replacement of two standby emergency generators and nine electrical control cabinets. At this particular Lift Station, the existing wet well interior will get a new coating, and the pumps, valves, and the electrical control cabinet will be replaced. Lift stations are large underground wells where wastewater from the neighborhood is collected. Since the ground elevation in Foster City is flat, wastewater has to be pumped from lift station to lift station, and eventually to the treatment plant in San Mateo. There are 49 lift stations in Foster City that are maintained by the Estero Municipal Improvement District. Due to the highly corrosive environment within the lift stations, many of the components have exceeded their useful life. Major work items included in the project are installing bypass connections; repairing corroded wet well concrete; installing new protective coatings; replacing electrical components and control cabinets; and replacing valves, pumps, piping, and fittings. With these improvements and proper continued maintenance, the useful life of these lift stations will be extended.

HOURS OF CONSTRUCTION

Working hours will be between 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

HOW WILL CONSTRUCTION AFFECT YOU?

The City and the Contractor will make every effort to minimize inconvenience to the public during construction. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.

Schedule: Starting September 10, 2018 (approximately 9-10 weeks)

Noise: The work will result in a temporary increase of noise.

Traffic: To facilitate timely completion and ensure public safety as well as safety of the Contractor's personnel, temporary re-routing of pedestrian traffic through the work area may be required. Please observe the posted signs around the work area. The Contractor will install temporary construction fence around the perimeter of the work area to secure the work site.
